

DP PROGRAM

n the DP, you are required to take English, Geography, Math and a second language class. And you will have to choose between Art or Chemistry, and Biology or Computer Science. Half of your classes will be HL (higher level) and half of your classes will be SL (standard level). When it comes to choosing your HL's, there are a few things that I strongly recommend you keep in mind. Firstly, what classes did you enjoy in the 10th grade? Many of the factors that determine whether you like a class or not, will be the same even in IB. For example, the teacher, the overall atmosphere of the class and the grading style. If you didn't enjoy a certain class before IB, you're probably not going to magically start liking it in IB. It's more likely that your feelings will stay the same. Secondly, think about your future career. If you are planning on working in the medical field, you might wanna take HL Biology and Chemistry. If you want to become an engineer, you should take HL Math and two HL Science classes. You should also know that many Asian and European universities require you to take HL maths and sciences to get into their STEM programs. If you want to become a lawyer, you should probably take English HL. And something else to think about is where you plan to go to college (if you decide to). If you want to go to a Japanese university I strongly suggest that you take Japanese HL whether you are a native speaker or not. Before you go into the DP, get as much information about the classes as you can. Ask teachers, students and even do some research online. Get all the information that you can to make the best possible decisions for yourself. And don't worry, when you get into the DP you will still have about a month to change classes.





QUEEN ELIZABETH II

n the afternoon of September 8th of 2022, the Queen of the United Kingdom passed away at the age of 96. In 2015 Queen Elizabeth II became the UK's longest reigning monarch surpassing Queen Victoria. In the February of 2022,



she celebrated the 70th anniversary of her accession. She was on the throne since 1952 and her coronation that took place in 1953 was the first ever to be broadcasted on television. Her coronation was viewed by more than 20 million people worldwide. She became the head of seven different countries of the Commonwealth: the United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Pakistan, and Ceylon (current day Sri Lanka). Now the Commonwealth is associated with 56 independent countries. The Queen dedicated her life to the Commonwealth. On her 21st birthday during her overseas tour in 1947, she stated "I declare before you all that my whole life, whether it be long or short, shall be devoted to your service and the service of our great imperial family to which we all belong."

Queen Elizabeth was known to break many royal and traditional standards. When she was still the princess, she was the first member of the royal family to join the military, a branch called Women's Auxiliary Territorial Service, and also pursued her interest in auto-mechanics there. She also consented to the parliament for the law of male primogenitor, where the male is favored to be the heir for the thrown. In more recent years she was known to be very modern, using different forms of Social Media like Instagram and Twitter.

While accomplishing many things throughout her reign, the people of the UK, the Commonwealth, and those from around the world have mourned her death. The throne was immediately passed down to her son, King Charles, who was the former Prince of Wales. On top of that, Prince William and his wife are now the Duke and Duchess of Cornwall and Cambridge, and also the Prince and Princess of Wales. And of course, the wife of King Charles has now become the Queen Consort (wife of a monarch).
