
DP ART EXHIBITION

Coachella- an annual and music arts festival featuring various music artists was held through mid to end of April. Over 250,000 people attended the widely popular music festival, and there were many impactful and surprising moments from this year's Coachella. To start off, Bad Bunny was the first Latin music artist to ever headline Coachella. Zendaya also surprisingly performed her first live performance in seven years, alongside Labrinth. BLACKPINK also made history by being Coachella's first ever K-pop act, stealing headlines and making their act one of the most notable Coachella performances this year. Various artists such as Frank Ocean and Harry Styles also performed unreleased and never heard before music.









SPACEX STARSHIP EXPLOSION Written by Megumi. B

On April 20, SpaceX's newest rocket, Starship, exploded only four minutes after launch. 120 meters tall, it is said to be the largest and most powerful launch vehicle ever flown. Fortunately, there were no crew onboard. Soon after the explosion, the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration) launched an investigation. There were no reports of injuries, nor were there any reports of any private property damage. However, it was found that there was a large amount of sand- and ash-like particulate matter as well as debris that spread miles beyond the launchpad. This has led to the disapproval by environmental advocates who worry that the debris could be harmful to local residents and wildlife, especially the endangered species in the area. Still, many consider this event to have been a "successful failure", claiming that although the launch wasn't 100% successful, Starship managed to reach its primary goal of collecting data and identifying potential errors for future launches. Recent reports have also been made that claim Musk, Space X's CEO and founder, lost close to \$12 billion dollars due to the failed launch.


